Winemaker's Notes

Established in 1893 Leasingham Wines has been an integral part of the Clare Valley for over 100 years.

Today, Leasingham's 260+ hectares of vineyards located throughout the Clare Valley provide the premium fruit, which along with the winemaking commitment and expertise, enable Leasingham to produce outstanding, award winning regional wine

2018 was a typical hot and dry season in Clare Valley. Spring rains brought good growth and soil moisture out of a relatively dry winter. After spring, rain events were quite sparse, and careful water management was the key to producing good fruit. Rieslings this year show great citrus fruit concentration and elevated mineral characters

Bin 7 Riesling is a classic example of this variety from the renowned Riesling region of Clare Valley in South Australia. Typically fine citrus and floral blossom aromas appear and the palate is soft and flavoursome with attractive lingering freshness.
