95 Points – Tony Love – Wine Pilot 2025 – “Sourced from two prized vineyards in the Barossa and Eden Valleys, hence the overarching “Barossa” zone labelling. The 2021 vintage is highly regarded across the region, and has delivered a 20/20 vision Cabernet Sauvignon expression: dark berried, some cassis, a sophisticated stitch of sensitive oak sitting behind the fruit, all wrapped in a subtly spiced, gentle dusting of tannins that give a complete yet soft finishing texture to the wine. A warmly welcoming Cabernet with balance and drinkability now, and for a good decade ahead.”

94 Points – Ken Gargett – Wine Pilot 2025 “A fine Barossa Cabernet, their flagship, from a highly regarded producer out of an absolutely stellar vintage – every reason to expect something a bit special here. The fruit is a combination of Barossa Valley and Eden Valley vineyards. An opaque maroon hue, there is an immediate ripeness to this wine, which is rather compelling. The nose exhibits an array of glorious aromas, including chocolate, licorice, blackberries, tobacco leaves, dried herbs and cassis. The oak integration is exemplary. A wine of well-crafted structure, giving us a supple texture, impressive length, serious intensity, fine balance and satiny tannins. The finish continues to linger long after the last sip. This is a ten year proposition, likely considerably longer if needed. A bit special indeed.”

94 Points – Dave Brookes – Halliday Wine Companion 2024 “A classically proportioned Barossa cabernet sauvignon with intense blackberry pastille, blackcurrant and black cherry fruits, edged by leaf and twigs and cut through with notes of clove, sage, cedar, cigar smoke, roast capsicum, wood spice and dark-chocolate bullets. Concentrated with a real black-fruit-pastille edge, compact tannins and a finish plush with brandied fruits, fruitcake and cassis.”
