The 2021 Vintage in the Clare Valley was near perfect as it had good winter rainfall in conjunction with mild temperatures during the ripening season

Bin 7 Riesling is a classic example of this variety from the renowned Riesling region of Clare Valley in South Australia. This is a light bodied wine that brings to the table all attributes that create a Clare Valley Riesling in addition to standout texture.
