2022 MUD HOUSE MARLBOROUGH ROSÉ

COLOUR

Pale blush pink.

NOSE

Bold tropical and refreshing citrus notes are complemented by hints of red berry.

PALATE

A lively palate that bursts with ripe tropical fruit, crisp acidity and juicy red berries. This wine is generously weighted with a delightfully refreshing finish.

VINEYARD REGION

Fruit for this wine was sourced from selected vineyards across the expanse of the Marlborough winegrowing region, including our company Woolshed Vineyard in the upper Wairau Valley, along with long established growers in the Awatere and Wairau Valleys.

SOILS AND PROFILE

Our Marlborough vineyards are situated on moderately fertile glacial soils. This includes a mix of sandy loam over very deep gravels, fertile loams and clays.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

It was overall a good growing season in Marlborough. Cloudy and humid conditions dominated the season, which, when combined with a rainy February, increased disease pressure. The lead up to harvest was relatively settled, albeit cooler than normal. As a result, the fruit was given plenty of time to ripen before being harvested in March.
