Prosecco (Glera)

COLOUR

Bright contemporary rose, showing a youthful crimson hue.

NOSE

Rich Lifted rose petal and red berry characters blending with the classic fresh pear typical of prosecco.

PALATE

Soft red fruits with a bright minerality and slightly savoury nature. Dry in taste, with just a hint of tannin adding texture to the fresh and fruity style.
