GRAPE VARIETY

Riesling.

COLOUR

Pale golden with green hue.

NOSE

Lemon zest and delicate florals of citrus blossom dominate upfront followed by crisp Granny-Smith apple and underlying toasted sourdough notes.

PALATE

Palate is undeniably intense with rich fruit flavours of apple and citrus. The extended time on lees and its acidity backbone have created a wine with a beautiful texture and balance that will certainly defy the test of time.

VINEYARD REGION

Eden Valley.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

Good rainfall in Autumn and desired Vintage was cooler than average which allowed for a slow and even ripening of fruit specially in dry grown conditions.

WINE ANALYSIS
