## GRAPE VARIETY Riesling.

COLOUR Pale Straw with hints of green.

### NOSE

Pronounced aromas of lime zest, ripe apple, meyer lemon and cherry blossom followed by notes of freshly baked bread and jasmine flower.

### PALATE

Crisp and refreshing acidity hits the palate first, carrying flavors of juicy citrus fruits—lime, lemon, and grapefruit—alongside crunchy green apple and slightly toasted bread. The rich fruit profile intensifies the midpalate. The finish is long and persistent, leaving a lingering impression of citrus zest and minerality.
