The palate delivers lemon and lime zest with crisp green apple and floral notes. The texture is complex with natural acidity balancing the primary dominate palate leading to a long finish.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2023 vintage was cooler and slightly wetter than average allowing for slow, even ripening across both regions. The result is a seamless blend from the best parcels creating a beautiful expression of Riesling with bright acid and zesty fruit.
