Katnook Odyssey Cabernet Sauvignon is one of 53 wines listed in the 'Outstanding' category of the Langton's VII, Classification of Australian Wine.

Made with the most meticulous attention to detail, Katnook Odyssey signifies a seamless blend of intense fruit and extended oak maturation.

Vintage Conditions:

Katnook Odyssey is created from small parcels of premium Cabernet Sauvignon grapes, sourced from the estate's terra rossa vineyards that consistently produce exceptional fruit with outstanding depth of flavour and firm tannin structures.

Coonawarra's 2021 vintage displayed all the hallmarks of an incredible harvest. Good winter and early spring rains, providing sound conditions for the vines upcoming growing season. Mild and stable weather conditions through summer with minimal heat fluctuations ensured optimal ripening, and minimal vintage rains ensured outstanding fruit quality during harvest.

Oak Maturation:

Matured for 16 months in French Oak Hogsheads, 40% new and 60% seasoned.

Food Matching:

Try a slow cooked lamb shoulder or porcini risotto with parmesan.

Colour:

Medium crimson with purple hues

Nose:

This Cabernet Sauvignon greets the wine lover with bright, aromatic notes. Dark berry fruits, such as plum, blackberry, mulberry and cassis abound. There is a backbone of spiced adding complexity to the aromatics, the wine shows all the hallmarks of the region from which it has come from.

Palate:

The palate is bright, fresh and vibrant yet full and supple. Flavours of plum, mulberry, cassis and blue fruit are supported by supple, yet defined tannins and quintessential Cabernet Sauvignon structure. Spices, and hints of cedar provide a long lingering finish. The wine shows great tension, providing an insight to its potential longevity.

Cellaring Potential:

This is an iconic Cabernet Sauvignon which will continue to grow 15+ years.
