An exercise in power and concentration, with aromas of plum, mulberry, white pepper, bramble and spice, all wrapped up with some classy French oak aromas. Full-bodied, mouth-filing, dark fruited and powerful. Full of dark fruits, nutty oak, spice and a dark, bitter chocolate edge. The tannins are textured and layered and there's lovely brightness and length on the finish".

95 Gold Halliday Points - Shanteh Wale Halliday Wine Companion 2025 - "Matured for 15 months in French oak. Fragrant with Bing cherries, satsuma plums and quince paste. There is fresh bay leaf and grevillea nectar, five-spice and cumin. The palate demonstrates the intertwining of lingering acidity and fine tannins, making for a sultry and, quite frankly, a damn sexy drink. This is everything it promises on the nose. Exudes the quality of site selection and the maritime climate of Coonawarra. A wine of distinction."
