The White Label range are crafted in the same Petaluma philosophy as the highly regarded yellow label. The grapes are grown in the key regions of Adelaide Hills and Coonawarra. These wines are perfect to enjoy upon their release and compliment occasions with friends, family and food.

### GRAPE VARIETY

Pinot Gris

### COLOUR

Light Straw.

### NOSE

The bouquet is dominated by nashi pear and white florals.

### PALATE

The 2021 White Label Pinot Gris shows crunchy, fresh pear and pink lady apple with an elegant structure on the palate. This wine's flavour is complemented by a long, fine citrus acid drive in conjunction with a hint of textured mouthfeel on the finish.

### VINEYARD REGION

Adelaide Hills

### VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2021 vintage was warmer than the long-term average. However, conditions through the growing season and harvest were consistently mild and dry. This vintage was near perfect and one to remember as the wines produced are of outstanding quality.

### WINEMAKING

The fruit for this wine was predominately machine harvested with some selected parcels being handpicked and bunch pressed. The parcels were cold settled and clean racked to stainless steel tanks for fermentation. Following this they were matured in stainless steel, filtered and bottled.

### WINE ANALYSIS

Residual Sugar: 1.13 g/L

### PEAK DRINKING

Drink now and for up to 3 years.
